Pathways Scholarship

The Pathways Scholarship was established at Howard Payne University New Braunfels in an effort to help pave a way for students to continue their education in New Braunfels after high school. This scholarship is intended to help students take the next step on their journey after completing a local community program such as Kid's Club, Communities in Schools, Young Life, Boy's and Girl's Club, LEAPS, SJRC, and Connections (this list may be subject to change based on the expansion of local partnerships).

Eligible students shall:

- Complete a program listed above in Comal or Guadalupe county
- Meet unconditional admission requirements as established by HPU (provisional acceptance may be considered on a case by case basis)
- Enroll at least part-time (6 hours/2 courses per semester)
- Apply and be eligible for financial aid
- Maintain a grade point average of 2.5 or higher each semester enrolled

Renewal:

The scholarship will apply \$500-1000 per year towards a student's tuition as they are pursuing an undergraduate degree at Howard Payne University New Braunfels. Students must reapply annually for the scholarship.

To apply, students will need to:

- Apply for free at hputx.edu/nb/apply
- Submit high school transcript
- Submit FAFSA (HPU Code: 003575)
- Request a reference letter from their respective organization to be submitted with the attached application form

Applications for this scholarship will be reviewed on April 1 and will be reviewed by our financial aid committee. Chosen applicants will be notified and awarded by May 20. Please submit the back portion of this form to newbraunfels@hputx.edu prior to April 1 for priority consideration.

Why HPU NB?
