In accordance with Howard Payne University's longstanding commitment to providing affordable, Christ-centered higher education to students and families in the Central Texas and Heart of Texas areas and beyond, HPU has established the Head Start Scholarship Program. Upon enrollment at HPU as a full-time first-year or transfer student, the HPU Head Start Scholarship program provides students who complete dual credit courses at Howard Payne and earn a grade of B or above in those courses with a scholarship equal to the cost of tuition paid for the aforementioned dual credit courses.

This HPU Head Start Scholarship Program is available to <u>all</u> students who enroll in dual credit or dual enrollment courses at Howard Payne, who receive a grade of B or above in those courses, and who enroll at HPU as a full-time first-year or transfer student following the students' high school graduation. The value of the scholarship will be dependent on the total dual credit hours completed with a grade of B or above multiplied by the cost per credit hour for each dual credit course, up to a maximum of 30 dual credit hours (approximately 25% of a standard Howard Payne University Bachelor's degree). The HPU Head Start Scholarship is a tuition-specific scholarship and may not be used toward non-tuition costs.

<u>Example:</u> The cost per credit hour for dual credit enrollment at HPU in 2022-23 is \$100/hour. If a high school student were to complete 18 dual credit hours with a grade of B or above during 2022-23 and were to enroll at HPU as a full-time first-year student in fall 2023, the student would receive a one-time scholarship in the amount of \$1,800, the full cost of tuition for the student's 18 completed dual credit hours.
