FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

- Students apply for financial aid by completing the Application for Admission, the Financial Aid Application and the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Students and parents can apply for a FEDERAL STUDENT ID (FSA ID) at studentaid.gov. The student and the parent will each need a Federal Student ID in order to sign the FAFSA electronically.
- Complete the 2024-2025 FAFSA at studentaid.gov. Use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (DRT) to load information from 2023 tax returns for both the student and the parents.
- Be sure to include HPU (Federal Code: 003575) when you indicate the schools you want to receive the results of your FAFSA.
- Some types of financial aid are available on a first-come, first-served basis; therefore, it is very important that students complete the application process as soon as possible.
- **SCHOLARSHIPS:** Reference the Scholarship Listing for Merit Scholarships. To apply for Departmental Scholarships (Music, Theatre, etc.), the student must contact the Head of the Department.
- **RANGE OF GRANT AWARDS:**

Pell Grants:	\$0 - \$3,698, per semester
SEOG:	\$0 - \$ 750, per semester
TEG:	\$0 - \$1,936, per semester

FEDERAL DIRECT STAFFORD LOAN AWARDS:

Freshman:	\$2,750, per semester
Sophomore:	\$3,250, per semester
Junior & Senior:	\$3,750, per semester
- **FINANCIAL AID PACKAGE** – After the financial aid application is complete, students receive an offer that included a combination of aid programs based on their financial need.
- HPU offers a flat tuition rate for full-time students taking 12-18 credit hours.
- **Estimated Semester Charges for per semester (fall and spring):**

- Bills for the fall semester (starting in August) and spring semester (starting in January) are independent of each other.
- **PARENT LOANS** – Parents of a dependent student may borrow up to the cost of education, less other types of financial aid. Parent must pass a credit check. If the student enrolls full time, parents may request postponement of their loan principal payment.
- **DEFERRED PAYMENT PLAN:** Students can select a deferred payment plan. Contact the Business Office at 325/649-8053 for more information on this option.
- **STUDENT EMPLOYMENT** – On campus jobs are available for all students. Student will need to fill out a Student Employment Application on their gateway.
