When does my paperwork need to be submitted to the School Certifying Official at HPU?

After you have completed the admission's process through the HPU Office of Admissions, submit the required documents (listed on previous page) to the SCO.

Will the military benefit cover the costs of tuition, fees, housing and meals?

That depends on your eligibility – something the military determines upon your application for education benefits. Below is a link to current VA pay rates.

Is my Financial Aid affected if I use my VA Education Benefits?

In most cases, yes. You will need to contact the HPU Financial Aid Office to be informed of how VA benefits and other scholarships can be awarded.

When can I expect payment from the VA?

The VA requests that you allow 30 days, minimum, for the processing of education benefits.

Does Howard Payne University participate in the Yellow Ribbon Program?

Yes. The Certificate of Eligibility that you receive from the VA will contain information regarding your eligibility for the Yellow Ribbon Program.

Does Howard Payne University accept the Hazlewood Act?

No, HPU is a private institution. Only public institutions in the state of Texas may participate in the Hazlewood Act.

What happens if I change my schedule?

NOTIFY THE SCO IMMEDIATELY. Schedule changes usually, but not always, affect your military payments. **Sometimes, this creates a debt for the student**. If you withdraw or drop classes from HPU *after the first day of class, a portion of your VA benefits may be charged*. VA education benefits DO NOT calculate based on HPU's refund schedule – refer to the HPU Catalog for the current refund policy.

I want to take a course that is not required for my major, as seen in my Academic Plan. Will the military pay for it?

No. The military will apply benefits only to courses required for the major you have chosen.

What happens if I change my major?

If you change your major, notify the SCO immediately with a copy of your new *Academic Plan* (list of required courses for your newly chosen major – located online in your Gateway account). A change in your major may cause courses you are currently registered for to become ineligible for reimbursement by the VA.
